

## Bakersfield-Wakayama Summer Cultural Study Program

Each summer, since 1988, Bakersfield Sister City hosts students from our Sister City of Wakayama, Japan. This year will be the 26<sup>th</sup> time that we have hosted this summer group. Wakayama's Sister City committee carefully selects the students who participate in this annual Cultural Study Program, which always includes a visit to Bakersfield, where the students have the opportunity to stay in the homes of American families. This summer the group of 27 junior high and 14 high school students will be visiting Bakersfield from Thursday, August 4 to Tuesday, August 9. Note that this will be only one week before the fall semester begins on Wednesday, August 17.

We are looking for families who would be willing to host two students for 5 nights/4 days. Though all of the students will speak some English, we always try to arrange the home-stays so that none of the Japanese students are "singles"; this helps both them and their host families to feel more comfortable. As home-stay hosts, you should simply continue with your normal activities, involving your guests as much as possible in a "typical" American family. The students will also be visiting the usual tourist attractions in the Los Angeles (Disneyland, Universal City Walk, etc.) and San Francisco areas. Those who have participated in the past in this home-stay program can tell you what a wonderfully rewarding experience it is. Often, these brief stays blossom into long-lasting friendships, even some multi-generational ones.

At this time, our plans for group activities have not been finalized. However, we are planning a required welcome party and other optional activities. This should still leave you with "family time" to bond with your guests.

If your family is selected to host we will contact you by Monday, June 20<sup>th</sup>, with the time and place for an orientation meeting. After we have received the final list of Japanese students, we will match them with their home-stay hosts, and give you their names and contact info. At the meeting, we will discuss what you may expect to experience as hosts and answer any questions that you may have. We will also have more definite plans for group activities to share with you at that time.
